EV Charging

(Electric Vehicles)

We are delighted to have installed an easee charging robot for EV driving cottage guests to safely and conveniently charge their electric vehicles.

The easee one is an untethered charger so it's a case of bring your own cable that works for your vehicle. I have an app on my phone to record consumption and cost. Just let me know at the beginning of your stay if you would like to use the charger and I can take the readings and do the sums so you know how much it has cost you.

We don't currently have the facilities to take card payments so payment in cash or a bank transfer only.

NB Charging of Electric Vehicles is NOT permitted from INSIDE Ardormie Farm Cottage

Please use our Easee Charging Robot situated in the car park on the wall of the shed. Please let us know if you wish to use the EV charger and we will record your usage.

DO NOT use a cable plugged into an internal electrical socket for the following reasons

- No 13-amp sockets rated for EV charging
- No connection with a dedicated RCD-DD device which would disconnect the live, neutral and earth conductors from the vehicle in the event of a fault
- Insurance could be invalidated

Current advice is that without the appropriate safety protocols being in place the body of the car could become live at any point, a normal 13A socket could catch fire, especially if that socket is close to a window and is in proximity to soft furnishings or curtains.
